The parts of a computer can be classified in two devices: -Input Devices and Output Devices.

Input Devices

Input devices help us feed data into the computer. The mouse ,keyboard, scanner and mic are input devices.

Output Devices

The output devices help us receive information from the computer. The monitor, speaker and printer are output devices.
